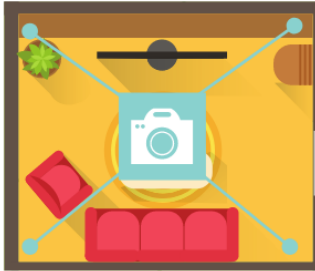



House Photos to Upload

*Rooms don't have to be tidy, and photos don't have to be perfect!
We just need a general sense of the space.*



HERE'S HOW TO TAKE PICTURES OF YOUR SPACE...

- 1 Open the curtains and take photos mid-day for best results. Turn on overhead lights if it's really dark. Turn off lamps. No flash!
- 2 Holding your camera a bit lower than eye level (about 40 inches from the floor), take photos in landscape mode. 
- 3 For interior spaces, take a photo standing in the doorway; then walk to each corner of the room and take a photo. Usually 2-4 photos per room is plenty. For exterior spaces, try to wait until the sun is at your back to take the photo.

Exterior

- Front (from the street)
- Front/Right Corner
- Front/Left Corner
- Front Porch
- Back of house, yard
- Side yards

Entryway

- From the front door, looking into the house
- From the end of the entryway area, looking toward the front door

For interior spaces, take a photo standing in the doorway; then walk to each corner of the room and take a photo. These are recommendations — please capture photos of all spaces that apply to your home.
